

Bandstra Transportation reserves the right to change or adjust any accessorial charge without notice. All interline shipments are subject to interline carriers rules and regulations. Charges will be applied according to the terms of the billing of lading unless otherwise specified.

1. ADDITIONAL LABOR CHARGES:

If additional labor is required to complete a job it will be charged at a rate of \$35 per hour per person. After hours callout time is charged at a minimum of 4 hours.

2. ADDITIONAL SERVICES (CRANE, PILOT CAR, ETC):

Any additional services booked and coordinated by Bandstra Transportation will be billed to the customer at the rate of the service plus 10%.

3. ADDITIONAL DELIVERY:

A surcharge will apply when a customer chooses to pay a truckload rate to the furthest point and requires multiple deliveries at different locations within the same city or within different cities.

4. ADDITIONAL PICKUP:

A surcharge will apply when a customer chooses to pay a truckload rate to the furthest point and requires multiple pickups at different locations within the same city or within different cities.

5. AFTER HOURS DELIVERY:

Minimum 4 hours charge will apply.

6. C.O.D. SERVICE:

If Bandstra Transportation is instructed to pickup cash or a certified cheque from the consignee before the freight may be delivered is subject to the following charges:

6% of the C.O.D. amount, minimum \$25.00 charge.

7. CUBE RULE:

All rates are subject to 10 pounds per cubic foot unless otherwise specified. If the cubic weight is more than the actual weight of the shipment then the cubed weight would apply to calculate the freight charges. When it is not possible to load on top of a shipment the cube dimension for the shipment shall be based on a minimum height of 8 feet.

8. DANGEROUS GOODS SERVICE:

Goods subject to the *Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act* are subject to the following charges:

1 – 1000 lbs	\$15.00 per shipment;
1001 – 10 000 lbs	\$30.00 per shipment;
Over 10 000 lbs	\$45.00 per shipment.

9. DECLARED VALUATION:

Maximum liability of carrier is \$2.00 per lb. unless declared valuation on original Bill of Lading states otherwise.

Declared valuation in excess of \$2.00 per lb. is subject to the following valuation charges:

1.5% of Declared Valuation, subject to acceptance by carrier.

10. FUEL SURCHARGE:

Rates and charges are subject to current fuel surcharge in effect at the time and place of shipping.

11. HEATED SERVICE

If service is indicated on Bill of Lading then the shipment is subject to a charge of 12.5%.

12. POWER TAILGATE SERVICE:

If the shipper or the consignee does not have proper shipping/receiving docks to ensure safe handling of the freight or the shipper or consignee requires the use of a hydraulic tailgate, the shipment is subject to the following charges:
\$1.75 cwt per shipment, minimum \$30.00 charge.

13. PRIVATE RESIDENCE DELIVERY:

A surcharge of \$50.00 per shipment will apply to freight delivered to a private residence location, regardless if the property operates as a business or not.

14. PRIVATE RESIDENCE PICKUP:

A surcharge of \$50.00 per shipment will apply to freight picked up at a private residence location, regardless if the property operates as a business or not.

15. REWEIGHT OF SHIPMENT:

Shipments are subject to reweighing using weight and measure Canada approved scales.

16. STORAGE CHARGES:

\$1.25 cwt per day (after 48 hours), minimum \$25.00 per day charge.

17. TARPING SERVICE:

If tarping is required it will be subject to the following charges:

Single trailer:	\$75.00 per occurrence;
B-Train:	\$100.00 per occurrence.

18. TAXES:

All shipments are subject to applicable taxes.

19. TRAILER DEMURRAGE:

Spotting a trailer will be offered free of charge for the first 24 hours. For any period thereafter, a fee of \$75.00 per day will apply.
